DOE extends Partial Stop Work Order

Last week, the Hanford Site extended the partial stop work order for the Vit Plant by a month until May 23. The extension allows us to maintain the current essential mission-critical operations posture in alignment with other Hanford contractors. This action enables us to remain at maximum teleworking and continue to support craft team members staying home and ready to serve. It can be lifted any time before that date if any level of work is planned to resume.
