Expanded reporting requests related to coronavirus

As an update to last week's guidance on reporting COVID-19 cases, the Department of Energy's Office of River Protection has asked us to expand those situations when we would ask employees to self report. Beginning today, if an employee has been tested but is still waiting for preliminary results, we ask you to self report through the below mechanisms.

Please self-identify in one of the following situations:

- If you have been tested but are awaiting results;
- If you have received an official presumptive positive test result;
- If you have received a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19 from a health care provider or public health authority.

If you are a non-manual or craft employee working for Bechtel, Amentum, or WTCC or a subcontractor:

Please call the WTP 24/7 number at 509-545-2776 and provide your name and phone number to the operator. The operator will notify a WTP Safety and Health professional who will contact you.

The S&H professional will ask the employee a list of questions (see attached) and then notify the Hanford Emergency Operations Center. The intent of this approach is to collect details to support informed decision making.
