The Hanford Site will continue in Phase 1 operations for the week of 10 August. Hanford Site leadership remains focused on the safety and health of our Site workforce, while deliberately and safely measuring work scope and resources to support and advance Hanford's cleanup mission.

Each week, we monitor and consider local and state COVID-19 data and trends, as well as Site workforce safety and security needs, when we determine the following week's work scope and posture.

I ask that you all stay focused on your personal health and that of your teammates. Please remember to remain aware of your wellness and if you feel sick or experience COVID-19-related symptoms, stay home. Relevant symptoms, per the Benton Franklin Health District, include the following:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fever or chills
- Muscle or body aches
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Headache

- Sore throat
- Congestion or a runny nose
- New loss of taste or smell
- Fatigue

It is critical to our mission and our community that individuals with symptoms not report to work, where they could spread the illness to coworkers. Please continue to follow established COVID-19 protocols at work and at home and notify your supervisor if you feel ill or test for COVID-19.
