



# SITE WORK APPAREL GUIDELINES

*Wear the right footwear for the environment you are in.*

## ACTIVE CONSTRUCTION ZONES (ACZs)

**All personnel must wear:**

- ✓ Long sleeve shirt or jacket (must cover the wrist)
- ✓ High-visibility outer garment (Shirt, vest, or jacket)
- ✓ Full length to the ankle pants, durable material with no holes, tears, or cuts



## NON-ACTIVE CONSTRUCTION AREAS

**Minimum site attire:**

## FOOTWEAR REQUIREMENTS

### SAFETY FOOTWEAR (Coming Soon)

- ✓ Steel or composite toe
- ✓ ASTM F2413 compliant
- ✓ Slip-resistant sole
- ✓ Above-ankle support



### FIELD WORK (Minimum: Substantial Footwear)

- ✓ Durable leather or equivalent material
- ✓ Slip-resistant sole
- ✓ Sturdy construction (boot or shoe)
- ✓ Provides protection against slips/trips



## NOT APPROVED FOOTWEAR

- ✗ Athletic, Casual, or slip-on shoes
- ✗ Lightweight or fabric footwear



## ADDITIONAL NOTES:

Substantial footwear is required beyond security entrances and T-28 Visitors Center unless otherwise specified

Winter conditions: select footwear that prevents slips (cleats allowed)

Radiological areas may require disposal of contaminated footwear

Supervisors may require employees to change if attire is not appropriate
